



The service includes a 15-minute telephone consultation with a GP after all laboratory results have been analysed. Due to the nature of the tests, the add-on is for those aged 40+ only.

The questionnaire uses age, sex, lifestyle, personal and family medical history to determine the most relevant tests for each employee. Early Cancer Add-on

Help gain peace of mind by identifying cancer risks

Spotting the signs of cancers early can be vitally important. In many instances, beginning treatment for cancer early can make all the difference. Our Enhanced and Elite health checks, which include tests for prostate (PSA) or ovarian (CA-125) cancer, can be upgraded with additional cancer risk tests. The Early Cancer Add-on has been specifically designed to assess further cancer risks of the stomach, bowel, and cervix. The Early Cancer Add-on is recommended for the over 40s only.

When looking at cancer tests, it's important to recognise that no test can be 100% perfect. While our tests can highlight cancer risk, 'false positives' (abnormal results where cancer is not present) and 'false negatives' (normal results where cancer could be present) can also occur. That's why all results will be explained fully in your employee's results report, and we include a 15-minute telephone consultation with a registered GP after all laboratory results have been analysed. The GP review can be used to discuss any worrying symptoms and if appropriate, a discussion can also take place in relation to any cancers that might run in the family.

What's included?



Stomach cancer risk

Helicobacter Pylori (H. Pylori) is a common bacterial infection which can damage the protective lining of the stomach and small intestine. H. Pylori is also a strong risk factor for certain types of stomach cancer and its infection level will be analysed through a blood test.



Bowel cancer risk

The qFIT test is an accurate method of identifying tiny particles of blood in stool, which can be an indication of bowel cancer. Your employees will be given a self-collection kit with full instructions on how to collect a small stool sample at home, which they then free-post to our lab for analysis.



Cervical cancer risk (female only)

HPV is the name given to a group of more than 150 viruses that affect the skin and the cells which line the body's cavities. An HPV infection will often cause no problems at all, however around 13 types of HPV can cause cancer. Your employees will be given a self-collection kit with full instructions on how to take a swab sampled at home, which they then free-post to our lab for analysis.



Tailor Made specialist health check

We are all different - our Tailor Made service is designed for those who want a health check to their precise needs

Building on a primary package of tests, extra checks are added based on answers to a confidential questionnaire. The questionnaire will assess age, sex, lifestyle, personal and family medical history, assigning at least 15 extra most suitable readings. For example, a PLAC test may be particularly relevant for someone who is overweight – whereas for another, hormone testing related to fertility may be more relevant to their health needs.

The service includes our musculoskeletal (MSK) motor function health scan which utilises the latest camera technology to track your employee's performance on a series of physical tests. In addition to this, your employees can also arrange a private 30-minute telephone consultation with an experienced MSK Practitioner, who can provide lifestyle information, exercises and advice for the effective management of aches and pains.



Give your staff the ability to track and monitor their health with ease

NEW for 2021, our convenient home test kits have been designed to help your employees understand their key health markers, while also addressing any mental health concerns they may have, all from the comfort of their own home. Ideal for every staff member, especially those working in the field or remotely.

How it works

Choose from four levels of testing offering up to 37 blood readings covering liver and kidney function, cholesterol levels, bone health and protein levels, plus a full blood count to help assess blood health and immune system. The Total home test kit also includes a vitamin D test to help assess deficiency - particularly common in the winter months - plus a thyroid function test to help detect thyroid disorders.

Employees will receive a home testing kit, which includes everything they need to take their own finger-prick blood sample. Once they return their sample, using the pre-paid shipping label provided, it will undergo full UKAS accredited laboratory analysis. Employees will receive their results online typically within 8 days, allowing them to understand what's happening inside their body without a long wait.

Virtual appointments

We know that collecting your own blood sample can sometimes be a little difficult, so we can support your employees to ensure they take their sample safely and successfully. Your employees can book their own private virtual appointment with one of our fully trained health coaches who will guide them through the sample-collection process step-by-step via webcam. Your employees can also book a full blood draw with a Health Assessment Specialist at one of our 2,000 venues nationwide if they would prefer.

FAQs

What health and wellbeing services are available to my workforce?

At Bluecrest we aim to offer the most convenient and accessible range of health and wellbeing services for your employees. Choose from our comprehensive health checks, home test kits or health awareness days, each designed to help you embed a culture of positive health throughout your workforce.

Where can my employees have their health checks?

Your employees will find their Bluecrest service extremely convenient. In addition to health checks at your premises (if you prefer), your employees will have access to the entire Bluecrest Wellness network of local venues. With services across 2,000 different convenient locations nationwide every year, your employees will find a high-quality venue no more than 10 minutes from their home or place of work – we ensure that all employees are always seen in private rooms.

What happens if my employees need to change their health check appointment?

We ask for all employees to please ensure they check their availability before confirming the date of their health check. We will always be pleased to rearrange appointment dates and times, however if they fail to attend on the day, we can't guarantee being able to accommodate them on a future date.

Are there any restrictions for having a health check?

Bluecrest health checks are only medically suitable for ages 18 - 79. We cannot offer our health checks to those who are pregnant.

How do employees prepare for their health check?

Fasting before a health check is not necessary. Employees can continue to eat and drink as they normally would, and prescribed medications should be taken as normal. However, we do ask to avoid vitamins and supplements as these can affect some results We recommend drinking plenty of water as this helps maintain blood circulation which makes it easier for our Health Assessment Specialists to take blood samples. Employees should wear loose and non-restrictive clothing i.e. no tights or stockings. This allows our Health Assessment Specialists easy access to arms and lower legs. We also recommend employees consider suitable attire if their health check includes an MSK health scan. Full preparation instructions will be provided in writing prior to any appointment

How long does a health check take?

We advise to allow around 30 to 40 minutes for the appointment depending on the selected health check package.

How long does a home test kit take?

We advise that all employees take advantage of our support service and book a virtual appointment with one of our fully trained health coaches (at no extra cost). Virtual appointments run for no longer than 30 minutes and help to ensure a safe and successful blood sample is collected.

Are results confidential?

Yes. The discussions your employees have, and results of any tests are completely confidential and will only be provided to them.

When are results available?

Full results reports are sent via post within 21 days of the health check (28 days in ROI), and are also available online via My Wellness. Home test kit results are available online within 8 days of the lab receiving the samples. Where results warrant urgent feedback, we provide dedicated, confidential, and proactive support to your employees. Our results reports are regularly reviewed by our Medical Panel and are considered to be one of the most detailed in the sector.

Can I be sure of quality?

Bluecrest staff performance is regularly monitored, to ensure we are giving a firstclass customer experience. We also regularly undertake phlebotomy audits to ensure high standards of practice within our team of Health Assessment Specialists.
